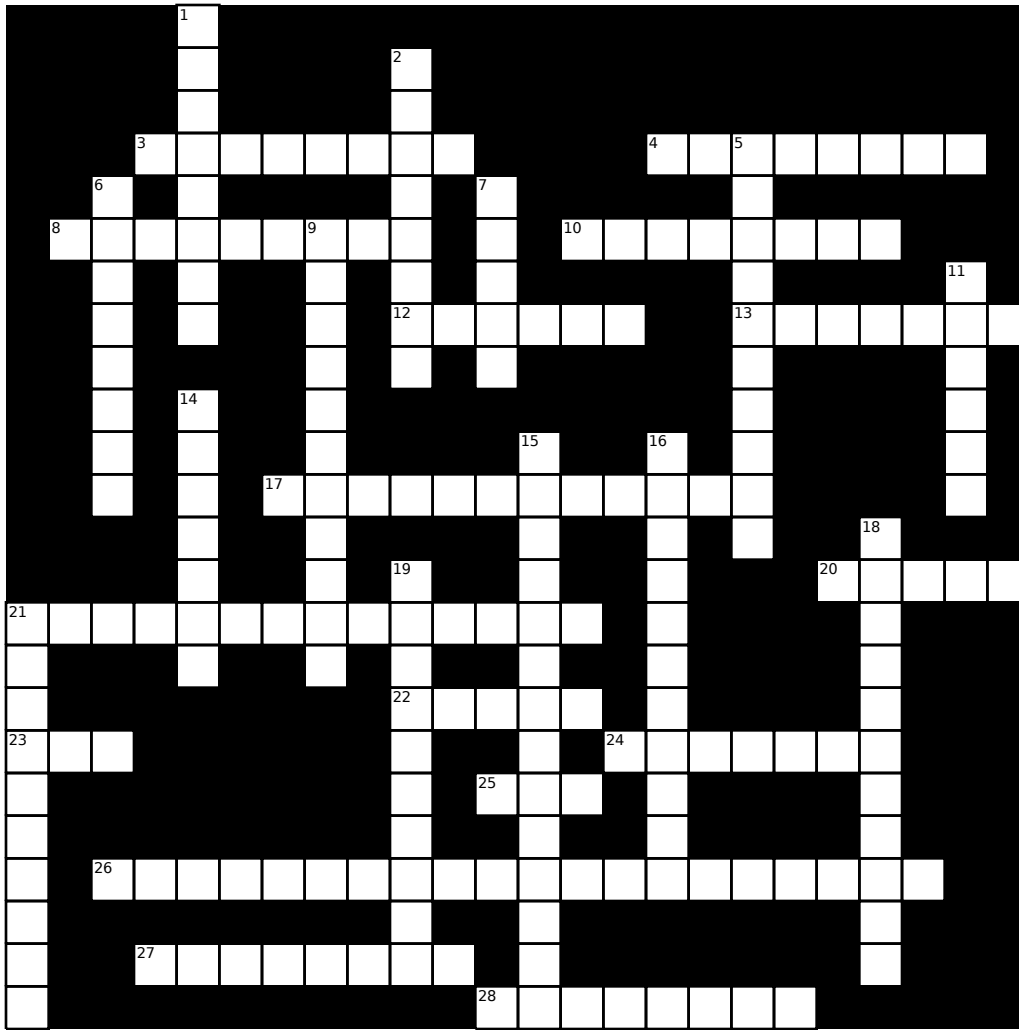


# Hardware Terminology
